

General Data Protection Regulation Information clause for information provided in the statement.

1. The administrator of your personal data is Centre for Culture in Lublin (CK) 12 Peowiaków street, 20-007 Lublin, phone. 81 466 61 00, email: sekretariat@ck.lublin.pl;
2. The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer who answers questions about processing your personal data. Contact with the DPO is possible at iodo@zeto.lublin.pl;
3. We will process your personal data to assess the epidemiological risk in Centre for Culture, in connection with the ongoing COVID-19 epidemic, and, consequently, ensuring the safety of participants of the events organized by the CK and introducing additional security measures during the event.
4. The legal basis for processing your personal data are “Guidelines for organizers of cultural and entertainment events during the SARS-CoV-2 virus epidemic in Poland”, developed by the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, the Ministry of Development and the Chief Sanitary Inspector.
5. Entities authorized under the provisions of law, entities with which entrustment agreements were concluded, and the Chief Sanitary Inspector may be the recipients of your personal data may be e
6. Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purpose for which they were collected, but no longer than for 14 days.
7. Providing your data regarding your health condition is obligatory because it results directly from the provisions of the CSI guidelines. In the event of a refusal to make a statement, for the good of other participants and Center’s employees, the organizer will refuse the participant his right to participate in the event. In terms of providing contact details, CIS recommends collecting such data to facilitate epidemiological investigation if a person which took part in the event, is found infected. Providing this data is voluntary.
8. Because we process your personal data, you have the right to:
 - ⌚ access this data and receive a copy thereof;
 - ⌚ correcting the data if it is incorrect, supplementing the data if you notice that it is incomplete;
 - ⌚ limit the processing of data, e.g. if you notice that your personal data is incorrect, until you check their correctness - for a period allowing us to check it;
 - ⌚ deleting data, e.g. when your data will no longer be needed for the purpose for which they were collected
